2.2	 although not a proposed revision, the wording of 2.2 (b) as written in the current framework is awkward and open to misinterpretation due to the use of a double negative; suggest rewording the following statement to ensure clarity:
	 "Applicants may only apply for funding if they are not currently ineligible to apply for, and/or hold, funds from NSERC, SSHRC, CIHR or any other research funding organization world-wide for reasons of breach of responsible conduct of research policies such as ethics, integrity or financial management policies"
2.7	 define/provide guidance on what is meant by "adequate" and "fair"
3.1.1	some agencies mandate data destruction after a certain period
Data Destruction	 ensure wording focuses on subterfuge/deceipt and not mandated deletions over time
4.2	 define/provide guidance on what is meant by "appropriate", "adequate", "fair" and "healthy"
